#### **January Tuition Reminder**

Please remember that even though we don't return from Christmas Break until 1/6/2020, January Preschool tuition is still due on January 1st!!

You are welcome to pay online via the PayPal link on our website, leave a check in the drop box outside of our main entrance or send it with your student before Christmas break begins on 12/19.

### Preschool Reminders

- Please do not block the entrances or exits with the car line. Staff, childcare and preschool vehicles are entering and exiting.
- As the weather gets colder please have your child ready to exit the vehicle when our staff member comes to
  gather them for preschool. Coat on, backpack ready to go, shoes on and ready to exit out the passenger door.
  Thank you for your support and understanding. There are up to 30 cars in each line and we want to keep our
  staff safe from the elements.
- You do not need to send your child to school in snow pants and/or boots. Boots are very hard to walk around in school and play in the large motor room. If there is every a time your class will go outside to play in the snow you will be notified beforehand to be prepared.
- Please remember to empty your child's backpacks. Lots of backpacks are full of art projects, information from school and curriculum pages. We are having a hard time fitting items in and there is a great deal of information coming home in the next month.

#### 2020-2021 Preschool Enrollment

talking to Ms. Becky regarding childcare classroom availability if you are wanting to switch your childcare days and times to work with your planned preschool enrollment.

## **Outside Play**

Weather permitting childcare will be going outside in the winter months. Please have warm clothes for your children (coats, hats, gloves and boots). Ensure all your child's winter gear is labeled with their name. Have them practice putting these items on/off as well to foster independence.

## Holiday Attendance

Holiday attendance sheets went up November 1. Please look for them in your child's room or ask Ms. Becky for the information if you haven't already filled them out!

If you plan to submit a vacation request, please remember that they must be submitted **2 weeks** in advance for approval!

## Childcare Reminders

- Please remember to empty your child's cubby. Many are full of art projects and information from school. There
  is a great deal of information coming home in the next month.
- The weather is officially cooler, please make sure all of your child's outerwear is labeled with their name and that they
  can identify their belongings. We want everyone to go home with the correct items. We are noticing lots of hats, gloves
  and coats without names on them.
- Please work with your children on putting on their coats, hats and gloves. It is a skill we are working on at school
  to supplement what you are doing at home.
- If your student wears boots to school during inclement weather, please make sure there is a pair of school friendly shoes in their backpack. Boots are tricky to maneuver at school, especially while playing in the Large Motor Room.
- Please ensure your children have a change of clothes in their backpacks. It's a good time to check to see if they are
  the correct size and weather appropriate.


# EAMILY EAITH FRIENDS
